2024 Materials & Services Charge

The Governing Council has approved the Materials & Services Charge. All the compulsory costs associated with your son/daughter's schooling are included in the total M&S Charge including subject charges for the whole year - some exceptions apply).

The figures are consistent with the current level of expenditure required to support our curriculum and give students at Oakbank School the best possible educational resources.

THE M&S CHARGE INCLUDES:

- ◆ All compulsory, curriculum related excursions R-12
- ◆ Textbook hire
- ◆ All stationery for Years R-7
- ◆ A student ID card
- ◆ Selected printed materials distributed throughout the year
- ◆ Initial allocation of printing & costs of internet downloads
- ◆ Consumables and use of equipment
- ◆ Access to the Internet and networked computers
- ◆ Access to Library resources

Payments by instalment can be arranged. Please see school finance staff if you have any questions.

2024 Materials & Services Charge rebate

Parents/carers will once again receive a \$100 rebate towards their 2024 M&S charge unless they are approved for schoolcard.

The Department for Education has issued instructions that this rebate must only be deducted from the M&S Charge for 2024 and cannot be used for camps, excursions or other charges.

Parents will receive a statement with their 2024 invoice which will clearly state credit notes. **Please note:** if paying by QKR! the amount listed is with the 2024 rebate already deducted for ease of processing.

Student ID Cards

At Oakbank School, year 7-12 students receive ID Cards included in cost of the M&S charge. Information on the card includes the student's photo, date of birth, and school student ID number. Benefits of having an ID card include: easy identification for the Passenger Transport Board; student travel concessions; concessions for any entrance fees for students & general identification.

NB: replacement card cost \$11.00 incl GST.



2024 Schoolcard Information

Applicants who apply for School Card assistance via an ED003A - Income Audit application form will need to complete the online application form. The online application form will be available at <http://www.sa.gov.au/education/schoolcard> or we can assist you at the school.

Parents/caregivers need to re-apply for School Card assistance for each year. By completing the ED003A application form online, the application form will be emailed directly to the government school(s) where the children attend, i.e. where two children attend different schools both sites will receive a copy of the application form.

Eligibility income limits for a student attending a government school – the information will be available in mid-January 2024 and we will issue this to parents at that time.

Please note by applying online, each school where you have children enrolled will be notified.

Parents/caregivers who do not apply for School Card assistance by 15 November 2024 will be required to pay the total amount of the prescribed school charge.

Dates & times for paying 2024 Materials & Service charges

Tax Invoices will be sent out after 18 January 2024 for the M&S Charges. For your convenience, the school Administration will be open during the vacation period for paying fees and other enquiries.

For 2024, the Oakbank School Governing Council wants to assist parents with the cost of the M&S Charge, alongside the Government rebate. They are offering the following incentives:

- (1) \$50 off the third child in a family, when fees are paid in full by 12 April 2024 and*
- (2) 3 raffle prizes of grocery vouchers for those who pay in full by 12 April 2024 or apply for Schoolcard by 12 April 2024.*







Oakbank School uniform information

School colours are navy & white



1. Polo shirts

R-12: Navy polo with white logo
All school polo tops must have a school logo.
Undershirts must be navy.

2. Jackets/Windcheaters

Primary, Middle, and Senior schools: ¼ zip navy fleece jumper with white school logo or navy soft shell jacket with white school logo
Year 6 and 12 commemorative tops, in school colours, as organised by the school.

3. Shorts

Plain navy

4. Skirt/Skort

Plain Navy/tartan

5. Pants

Plain navy pants, trousers, or neat track pants
Neat dark blue denim jeans will be trialled in 2024

6. Special uniforms

Tops for sporting teams will be supplied.
Agriculture – show team: navy & white checked shirt, navy vest, jeans.

7. Hats

Beanies and/or navy & white caps may be worn in winter.
Bucket hat with white school logo (with NO drawstrings) must be worn in each break during Terms 1 and 4 for all primary students.

Other clothing and accessories

8. Footwear

Students must wear trainers for physical education classes.
Fully enclosed flat shoes are required.
No Ugg boots, thongs or slip on shoes for safety reasons.
R-6 students may wear sandals or trainers; Year 7-12 require full enclosed trainers or school shoes

9. Rain jackets and wind breakers

Rain jackets and wind breakers can be worn over, but not instead of, school jumpers.
No oodles, blankets or other lounge attire.
